He concentrated on plans for handling TORNADOS. A short but very informative film convinced many of us that planning for A DEFENSE against TORNADOS is more scientific than we had thought. A SERIOUS AND LENGTHY (BUT SPONTANEOUS AND WILLING) DISCUSSION led to a short analysis of THE PLAN WHICH IS READY IN TREYNOR FOR THIS TYPE of disaster and other types.
