A NEW HOUSING DEVELOPMENT PLANNED FOR TREYNOR

Hans Schmidt spoke to Club members about plans for new housing in Treynor. According to Hans, Duggan Land Development of Council Bluffs has submitted plans to the city council for a housing development on the north side of Treynor. Hans said the first phase includes over 200 lots. A new access street is proposed north of Main street or Highway 92 at the end of Zion Cemetery. Another access is planned north of Treynor to run from L55 to the east. After new street alignments are decided, construction will begin. This might not occur until early Fall after the current crop on the development land is harvested.
