



### **Treynor City Manager**

Bryce Poland and Tom Lewis spoke at the Treynor Optimist Club on Saturday, February 7. They focused their discussion on the need for a City Manager position for Treynor.

The new city manager for Treynor will be a full time job and require a college degree. Experience will be a key hiring criteria, along with working well with people. The pay will be \$55K-\$65K.

The city manager will have a variety of responsibilities. Since the mayor and much of the city council work out of

town, the manager will have day-to-day as well as long term planning responsibilities.

Some of the issues facing Treynor are wastewater treatment, urban renewal, economic development, community improvement, a sidewalk plan, and promoting the city through its website. The city manager will plan and coordinate addressing these issues, as well as working on grants to fund some of them.

A city manager should be able to help improve the efficiency of city services and provide long term planning for actually getting things done. The city has contracted with a consultant firm to help hire someone for the position.
