Dear Neighbor,

The Treynor Optimist Club is continuing a community service and fundraising project to put up flags on seven holidays in Treynor again this year. This project enhances an already beautiful neighborhood with our country's flag. The Optimist Club members will put up, take down, store and maintain the flags for you. We would like to include your home on our list for this service in 2025.

The Treynor Optimist Club is preparing the flags for this year. Armed Forces Day is the first "Flag" day of the year and we are looking forward to serving you. The funds raised by this project go directly to support Scholarships for Treynor graduates. In May 2024 we gave \$500 scholarships to 16 students (\$8000) with funds from this project. We expect to give \$9000 in 2025.

In 2021 we began purchasing some new flags for high winds. They are brighter in color (whites and reds) and hopefully will last longer. We are slowly retiring the older flags, so you may notice a wide variety in the color of the flags again this year. We had a lot of flags destroyed from wind in 2024 and hope to have less problems with year.
