IOWA WEST FOUNDATION GRANTS ARE FOR COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT

Leo Olsen spoke to Club members about the activities of the Iowa West Racing Association and the lowa West Foundation. Leo is a member of both groups. The Racing Association is a nonprofit license holder for Bluffs Run and the two casino boats in Council Bluffs. From the dog track and the casinos income to the Association, the Foundation distributes grants to charities and public entities in southwest lowa. Leo stated the goal of lowa West is to make the community a better place to live. One of the larger grants has been designated as matching funds for the new Council Bluffs library building. Leo indicated that grants are being offered twice a year now, but there have been fifty applications to each one approved. According to Leo the Foundation favors proposals which will create a lasting benefit for the community. He indicated Treynor has not submitted many grant requests and he encouraged Treynor citizens to develop plans and submit an application for Foundation funds. Matching funds are favored, but are not required.
