At the camp children are teamed with an adult companion (other than their parent) for a week of adventures, outdoor activities, and time away from the worry of cancer. Since many of the children have been through the rigors of cancer treatment, this time is certainly a big improvement in Quality of life. The camp is held at the Easter Seals Campground near Milford, NE. However, it can move to other locations. Oncology pediatric nurses volunteer their time to be medical staff for the week. They need more adult volunteer companions, and Lois would love to have Treynor volunteers. The Camp is free to the children, which means it relies upon the community for financial support.
