DIVING AT THE ZOO

Dave and Bev Brandt of rural Council Bluffs are certified scuba This allows them to pursue their volunteer efforts at Henry Doorly Zoo where they help take care of the octopus and anemones by feeding, and cleaning their display tanks. Dave said he has been certified for scuba diving since 1975 and Bev has been certified since 1985. They are among the 165 divers who help take care of all the aquatic life at the zoo. explained that they sometimes work with the sharks and larger fish in the aquarium tank, which contains 400,000 gallons of filtered and conditioned water on display, and a like amount in the rest of the water system. Collecting shark eggs is an interesting experience, Bev noted, as the sharks keep a close eye on the process, although they are not aggressive or possessive in any way. Dave explained they volunteer 3-4 hours each week for routine and non-routine duties and enjoy their roles caring for the aquatic life.
