Gina Fricke is a Therapist for the Gambler Assistance Program of Family Service in Council Bluffs. She often gets referrals from the toll free phone number set up for nine southwest lowa counties for persons who recognize they have a problem with gambling. Gina explained that 7% of the population has an addiction problem that has developed by the gradual increase of time and money spent on gambling. A solution (and prevention) is to limit time and to use only 'disposable' money for gambling. Gina noted that the gambling problem of one person often impacts ten others.
