However, Gail said she is concerned that some younger girls are getting 'burned out' in sports as a consequence of parent's pushing their participation in club sports programs. According to Gail she has mellowed a little in her expectations of players, but this is mostly due to individual player situations. Southwest lowa girls sports are very competitive and coaches and players have to work hard to be on top. Gail said she has no plans to retire, but there might be some parents of younger elementary girls disappointed when their child reaches high school. She often gets inquiries from new parents if she will be there to coach their daughter.
