The SPY spoke at the Treynor Optimist Club on October 26. They made a mission trip to the Standing Rock Sioux Nation in North Central South Dakota. The trip was in July-August and organized through Youth Works. 12 youth and 3 adults went on the trip.

Up to 70 youth and adults participate in the program each week during the summer. Each day consists of a devotional, Kids Club, and work projects.

Devotionals are about 30 minutes. They have worship time at night where they read a verse of scripture, talk about it, and have adult sharing. The last night they have foot washing, where the adults wash feet of the youth and pray for them individually.

Kids Club is a safe place for children. It continues for nine weeks in the summer. They had a carnival the last day, with face painting and races. The SPY were there the last day of summer camp.

The work projects included helping an older lady paint her garage, painting school bleachers, and putting up a fence. Robert Whitemountain had three sons who attempted suicide. He moved back to the reservation, started some community gardens, and provided horses.

There was another group of youth from four small churches in Wisconsin. They were not as open as other groups in the past to making new friends.

A typical day started at 7:30 with breakfast, devotional, prayer, work projects/Kids Club, and lunch. At 3:00 p.m. they had showers, free time, and dinner. In the evening they had an activity and club time.

There were about 30 local kids at Kids Club each day. There were 60 for the carnival.
