Optimists visit the Glenwood Redemption Center

The Treynor Optimists visited the Glenwood Redemption Center on Saturday, January 6. John Klein arranged the visit and seven Optimist members toured the facility.



The Center recycles for five different vendors: Pepsi, Coke, Dr. Pepper, Dahl Distributing, and Crinc (recycling center in Des Moines). Plastics are sorted by size of bottles and companies. Vendors take only their own cans, plastics, and bottles. Cans are sorted 240 cans per bag. Crinc in Des Moines takes all of the odd bottles, which are sorted by light and dark glass.

Some redemption centers have storage problems, but the Glenwood facility has a large shed across the street from where they are located which is used in the summer for sorting.

There are six staff members including the Director Diana Sayers, who gave the tour, a driver, a lead staff person plus three others. There are seventeen clients of the Glenwood Resource Center who work there full time. It is a popular job and clients apply and are interviewed for passion. They are tested to determine their production rate and paid accordingly.

The Center is a noisy, dirty job so lots of cleaning is required. Ear plugs and gloves are provided to the 17 clients who do the sorting at the Center.

The driver picks up at 48 different locations, Tabor, Malvern, all Casey's, and Treynor is one of the most distant locations. The Redemption Center appreciate that the workers at the Can Kennel in Treynor sort out unwanted trash from the recyclables. The Optimists thank the community members who take care to not add unwanted trash.
