Wayne Casson Speaks

Wayne Casson, Commander of the Lamar Hartje American Legion Post #725 of Treynor, spoke to the Treynor Optimist Club on Saturday, October 13. The Legion meets once a month in the smaller room, known as the Lamar Hartje American Legion Post #725 Room at the Treynor Community Building.

One of the goals of the Legion is to promote the military and veterans. They do that with their flag project. To continue that goal they will help the Treynor Optimists with money for flags or what the Optimists need to continue the project. The Legion is no longer putting up flags because of the risk involved.

During the Optimist Club meeting the group voted to sell flags by the cemetery and high school for \$35 each. Any person, family or business can buy a flag to support the community. A donors' list for these flags will be published. The local Legion Post will check to see if they are able to buy flags for a lower price than the current price the Optimists pay.

Casson spoke about the Post's desire to have a static display on the Treynor Community Building property. They were close to getting a helicopter to display but were misinformed about it being

just a shell without many parts. They will continue to work on this effort of buying a piece of military equipment to display.

The Legion gives scholarships each year, which are funded by the Fish Fry meals served from 5:30 – 7 PM at the Treynor Community Building. Dates for 2019 are Jan 14, 28, Feb. 11, 25, and March 11, 25. The net proceeds determines the number of scholarships given.

The Legion sponsors "Let's Play Bingo" starting at 6:30 PM to be held Nov. 10, 17, and Dec. 1 and 15.

A fall decorative basket was donated by Dee Gutttau and sold for \$10.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned by stating the Optimists Pledge.

Board Meeting

Bill Vorthmann, Dale Willenborg, Gary Gutttau, and Keith Denton attended the Optimist Club Board meeting.

The main order of business was to assign organizations for the can kennel. Eleven applications have been received. The web site, www.treynoroptimist.org has been updated to reflect the 2019 assignments. Two months are still open.

The board discussed having someone in charge of the can kennel each month. They also decided that only two Optimist members are

needed at each sorting. Sometimes there have been more Optimist members than the receiving organization provides.

Gary Gutttau stated flag receipts totaled \$5810. The plan is to give 11 \$500 scholarships in 2019. The remainder is needed for new flags, footings, and publicity. Six scholarships have not been picked up yet for 2018.
