



He also said that www.familysearch.org has lots of free information plus www.newspaper.com also has lots of information.

Dale searched a few of the members present today to share what can be found: Jim Clausen, Judy Gutttau, Mick Gutttau, and Dale Willenborg. Some information that can be found is: business address, previous home addresses as well as current address, marriage records, birth dates, death dates, pictures of tombstones (and sometimes the plot), pictures from year books and other pictures, plus listing of times you've been in the newspaper. From a person's name, you can access their spouse, parents, sibling information.

Dale stated that the pictures on these sites come from volunteers – boy scouts, members of LDS church, and just interested people. Dale stated that Germany has kept very good records of their citizens.

From draft records you can learn height, weight, hair and eye color. Census records through the years can be accessed. Dale stated he has been able to go back to 1420 to his grandmother's mother's side.

If you Google on Root's Magic, you can learn more about who you are related to. It also will show locations where there are relatives of yours. Dale has 70 first cousins and has met all of them.

He likes tapping on an address and learning who has lived there before. Dale says he spends 5 hours a week on just his family history and has done that for two years. He had hoped to finish a year ago. He saves the info he finds in "Notes".
